Re: Guidelines and rules for users of National Park lands set aside for public use and recreation by citizens of the U.S. of A.

My family members and I enjoy hiking, mountain bicycling, and off-road 2 wheel Motorcycling. The "dirt bikes" have U.S. Forest Service approved spark arrestors and 92 to 93 decibel mufflers to limit noise output. We have areas of land in New Hampshire and Maine ( both public and private) that are off limits to registered 2 wheeled motorcycles, yet are torn up by heavy equipment and clear cut by logging Companies large and small and not replanted. How is that "caring for the forests And watersheds?"

BLM lands are open for mining in addition to logging, yet in some areas closed to 2 and 4 wheel ATV use.

Off road riders on 2 wheels don't drink alcohol, or use drugs in conjunction with any of their off road activities, and in 12 years of attending weekend long competitive riding events and meetings, Ive never seen any individual under the influence of substances. An example would be the New Hampshire two day "Classic Trail Ride" held in June each year attended by over 400 riders and raising over \$100,000.00 every year for the last 10 years for cystic fibrosis foundation.

Two and four wheel ATV users enjoy clean, family oriented recreation outdoors-non destructive to the environment with minimal impact to the lands, forest, and creatures therein. We should be allowed to use some of the forest trails and roads, as are hunters, horse riders, and campers.
