## Comments

I'd like to recommend that the monitoring be completed annually instead of biennially. I feel that looking at the status and where the Forest Service stands every two years is not frequent enough. An annual review is needed in order to stay on top of accomplishments and results of those accomplishments, what effects occurred, and where changes are needed.

If the biennial monitoring is selected, then I would recommend that an annual report be completed that shows accomplishments related to miles of firelines maintained and/or established, acres burned, acres planted, acres commercially thinned, acres with regeneration harvests, acres with biomass removal, miles of streams adjacent to accomplished activities, acres of soil rehabilitation, recreational visitors, number of developed campsites maintained and/or established, number of undeveloped campsites maintained and/or established, acres of wildlife foodplots maintained and/or established, number of wildlife structures maintain and/or established.

Also, annually there needs to be an evaluation done of each ecosystem within the forest as to current condition compared to desired condition in comparison to previous year(s).
